Purpose: To promote the continuous efficient, forward progress of students through the educational systems of New Mexico, the Board of Regents of Northern New Mexico Community College endorses those practices and matrices which facilitate the intrastate transfer of credit and supports the development and implementation of a statewide articulation plan. To this end, the Board of Regents understands that all students awarded the Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree by Northern New Mexico Community College, an accredited post-secondary institution, will be accepted at the junior level* in baccalaureate degree-granting institutions.

Policy: *Students will be allowed to register as juniors. They may be required to take lower division course work to fulfill specific baccalaureate degree requirements. This interpretation will be published in catalogs and student transfer guides.
